

GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF FIJI DECREE NO. 6

EXPORT-IMPORT BANK OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA LOAN DECREE, 1989

A DECREE TO AUTHORISE THE GOVERNMENT TO RAISE FROM THE EXPORT-IMPORT BANK OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA A LOAN OF UPTO AN AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO TWO MILLION AMERICAN DOLLARS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING EQUIPMENT

In exercise of the powers vested in me as President and Commander-in-Chief of the Republic of Fiji, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister and the Cabinet, I hereby make the following Decree—

*Short title*

1. This Decree may be cited as the Export and Import Bank of the Republic of China Loan Decree, 1989.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Decree, unless the context otherwise requires--

"dollar" means a dollar in the currency of the United States of America;

"Government" means the Government of the Republic of Fiji;

"loan" means the loan authorised by section 3 of this Decree;

"Minister" means the Minister of the Government responsible for finance.

*Authority to raise loan*

3. The Minister is hereby authorised to raise from the Export and Import Bank of the Republic of China a loan of upto an amount equivalent to two million dollars for the purpose of financing the purchase of equipment for use by the Government.

*Loan to be evidenced by instrument*

4. The loan shall be evidenced by an instrument under the hand of the Minister or such other person as the Minister may by writing under his hand so empower.
