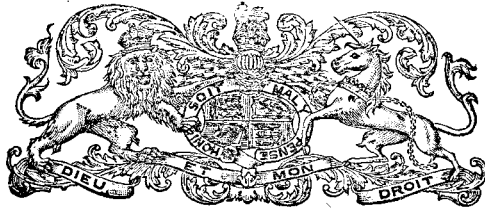

KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE FORMER ENEMY ALIENS
REGULATION 1919.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Former Enemy Aliens Amendment Regulation 1919. SHORT TITLE.

2. Section two of the Former Enemy Aliens Regulation 1919 is hereby amended and shall be read as if the words "and includes any naturalised British subject who previous to naturalisation was a citizen or subject of any such State" did not occur therein. SECTION 2 OF REGULATION NO. 5 OF 1919 AMENDED.
