An Act to amend the *Motor Traffic Act 1937*

*Certified on 10 October 2012*

Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

**1 Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act 2012*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on a date fixed by the Minister by Gazette notice.

**3 Act amended**

The Schedule amends the *Motor Traffic Act 1937*.

**44 Regulations**

- (1) Cabinet may make regulations under this Act.
- (2) The regulations may provide for:

- (a) any matter relating to road safety; and
  - (b) fees and the waiver or reduction of fees; and
  - (c) deposits on number plates or trader's plates; and
  - (d) fines, not exceeding \$100, for offences against the regulations.
- (3) The regulations may:
- (a) be of general application or vary in their application according to prescribed factors; and
  - (b) give the Minister, the Head of the Department or the Registrar discretion to decide a matter.
