A N O R D I N A N C E

To Amend the Nauru Local Government Ordinance 1951-1954.

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article I of the Agreement dated the second day of July 1919 between the Government of the United Kingdom, the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, as follows:-

Short title
and citation.

1.-(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Nauru Local Government Ordinance 1955.

(2.) The Nauru Local Government Ordinance 1951-1954 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.


(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Nauru Local Government Ordinance 1951-1955.

Power of
Council to
make rules.

2. Section 44 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (i) from sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:-

"(1) apprehending and impounding any pig or other live-stock by whomsoever owned found straying on any public road or place or on any unfenced land abutting on any public road or place, and for the establishment and control of pounds for the holding of any such pig or live-stock".
