ALTERATIONS TO THE CONSTITUTION

Whereas Article 92 of the Constitution of Nauru provided that the Constitutional Convention continued in existence during the period of five months after Independence Day or, if the Constitutional Convention approved by resolution a shorter period, during that shorter period;

And whereas that Article empowered the Constitutional Convention to alter any provisions of the Constitution other than Clause (4) of Article 85 and Article 92 by resolution approved by a majority of the members of the Constitutional Convention,

It is notified that on Friday, the seventeenth day of May, 1968, the Constitutional Convention, by resolution approved by a majority of its members, altered the Constitution of Nauru and immediately thereafter dissolved itself.
