PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2023

PURSUANT TO the powers in that behalf vested in me under Section 81, subsection 1, 2 and 3 of the Public Service Act 2016, the following days shall be observed by the officers and employees of the Public Service as Public Holidays for the year 2023.

Wednesday 1 st February, 2023	Day following Independence Day
Wednesday 8 th March, 2023	International Women's Day
Friday 7 th April, 2023	Good Friday
Monday 10 th April, 2023	Easter Monday
Tuesday 11 th April, 2023	Easter Tuesday
Wednesday 17 th May, 2023	Constitution Day
Saturday 1 st July, 2023	RONPHOS Handover
Saturday 19 th August, 2023	Ibumin Earoeni Day
Monday 25 th September, 2023	Sir Hammer DeRoburt Day
Thursday 26 th October, 2023	Angam Day
Monday 25 th December, 2023	Christmas Day
Tuesday 26 th December, 2023	Day following Christmas

Whenever a day specified in subsection (1) except Independence Day and Christmas Day, falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the following Monday is a holiday.

Whenever **Independence Day** and **Christmas Day**, falls on Saturday or a Sunday the following Monday and Tuesday are holidays.
