AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "*Arms, Liquor and Opium Prohibition Ordinance, 1911-1916.*"

[RESERVED 14TH JULY, 1932.

ASSENTED TO 4TH OCTOBER, 1932.]^(a)

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1924*, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Arms, Liquor and Opium Prohibition Ordinance, 1932.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Arms, Liquor and Opium Prohibition Ordinance, 1911-1916*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Arms, Liquor and Opium Prohibition Ordinance, 1911-1932.*

2. Section Thirteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting therefrom the following words:—

“and under the direct control of some specified person who is not a native within the meaning of such last-cited Ordinance.”

Amendment of
Schedule,
Form B.

3. Form B of the Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting therefrom the following words:—

“But no such native is permitted to use firearms except whilst he is under the direct control of the person whose name is endorsed on this permit.”

Passed in Council this fourteenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.

Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the fourth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.
