AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Public Service (Lieutenant-Governor's Leave) Ordinance, 1933."

[RESERVED 11TH AUGUST, 1939;
ASSENTED TO 15TH NOVEMBER, 1939.]^(a)

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1934*, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Service (Lieutenant-Governor's Leave) Ordinance, 1939*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Public Service (Lieutenant-Governor's Leave) Ordinance, 1933*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Service (Lieutenant-Governor's Leave) Ordinance, 1933-1939*.

Section 2 (1).

2. Subsection (1) of Section Two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following words “‘benefits conferred upon officers’ within the meaning of this subsection shall include and be deemed always to have included the right of a deceased officer to have the money value of the leave due to him at his death paid as prescribed.”

Passed in Council this eleventh day of August, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.

Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the fifteenth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
