AN ORDINANCE

To Grant and Apply out of the Public Revenue a Sum for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In addition to the sums authorized by the *Appropriation Ordinance, 1921-1922*, there shall and may be issued and applied for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the sums in the said Schedule respectively set forth amounting to Three thousand and fifty pounds.

£3,050 appropriated to the Service of 1921-1922.
