

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 2 of 1938.

Made under the *Native Regulation Ordinance*, 1908-1930.

The *Native Regulations*, 1931 (Statutory Rules No. 7 of 1931), are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting immediately after Regulation 39 thereof the following new regulation:—

“*Remand.*

39A. Any person summoned under these regulations may be remanded in custody by a magistrate for any period not exceeding seven days. The magistrate remanding any such person shall make out a remand warrant under his hand in the form set out in the First Schedule.”

2. By adding at the end of the said regulations the following Schedule:—

“FIRST SCHEDULE.

REMAND WARRANT.

(*Native Regulations*, 1931, Regulation 39A.)

To the Principal Police Officer at _____ in the Territory of Papua and to all other Police Officers in the said Territory, and to the Gaoler at _____ in the said Territory.

Whereas _____ was this day charged before me for that he did _____ contrary to the provisions of Regulation _____ of the *Native Regulations*, 1931, and it appears to me necessary to remand the said _____. These are therefore to command you the said Police Officers, in His Majesty's name, forthwith to convey the said _____ to the Gaol at _____ in the said Territory and there deliver him to the Keeper thereof together with this warrant, and I command you the said Keeper to receive the said _____ into your custody in the said Gaol and there safely keep him until the _____ day of _____ * or such earlier day as may be lawfully ordered in that behalf when I hereby order you to have him at _____ in the said Territory at _____ o'clock in the _____ noon before such Magistrate for Native Matters as may then be there, further to answer the said charge.
