

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 10 of 1929.

Made under the *Plants' Diseases Ordinance*, 1911-1913.

The *Plants (Importation) Regulations*, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 4 of 1923), are amended as follows:—

By inserting immediately after Regulation 7 thereof the following new regulation and heading:—

“Importation of coffee seed.

7A. No coffee seed shall be imported or introduced into the Territory except when obtained by or through the Director of Agriculture. Any coffee seed imported or introduced in breach of this regulation may be seized and destroyed by any officer of Customs.”
