

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 10 of 1939.

Made under the *Port Moresby Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1925-1938.*

The *Electricity (Port Moresby) Regulations, 1932* (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1932), are further amended as follows:—

1. By adding at the end of the Schedule the following new rate:—

Rate 11—Large Consumers.

“ A discount of Ten per centum in any month shall be allowed when an installation consumes not less than 1,000 units provided that payment is made on or before the last day of the month in which the account is rendered.”

2. This regulation shall be deemed to come into operation from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
