



STATUTORY RULES.

No. 11 of 1932.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

The *Public Service Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 9 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

1. By adding at the end of line (a) of Regulation 5 thereof after the word "Lieutenant-Governor" the following words and symbols:—
" (except so far as he is expressly referred to therein)."

2. By adding at the end of Regulation 52 thereof after the word "Court" the following further words:—

"and to the Lieutenant-Governor. In the case of the latter applications for leave shall be made to the Commonwealth Minister of State charged with Papuan affairs, and all powers which, in the case of other officers may be exercised by the Lieutenant-Governor, may in the case of the Lieutenant-Governor be exercised by the Minister."
