

# POUNDS ORDINANCE 1925.<sup>(1)</sup>

No. 28 of 1925.

## An Ordinance to amend the Pounds Ordinance 1920, and for other purposes.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Pounds Ordinance 1925*.<sup>(1)</sup> Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Pounds Ordinance 1920*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Pounds Ordinance 1920-1925*.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three. Commencement.

4.—Regulations 1, and 3 to 13 inclusive, of the *Pounds Regulations 1923*,<sup>(3)</sup> and the Schedules to those Regulations, shall be deemed to be as valid and effectual as if this Ordinance had been in force at the date upon which it is deemed to have commenced. Validation of
