

# SALE OF BREAD ORDINANCE 1925.<sup>(1)</sup>

## No. 29 of 1925.

### An Ordinance to repeal certain Ordinances relating to the Sale of Bread, and for other purposes.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Sale of Bread Ordinance 1925*.<sup>(1)</sup> Short title.
2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three. Commencement.
3. The *Sale of Bread Ordinance 1920* and the *Sale of Bread (Amendment) Ordinance 1920* are repealed. Repeal.
4. Regulations 1, and 3 to 19 inclusive, of the *Bread Regulations 1923*,<sup>(2)</sup> and the Schedule to those Regulations, shall be deemed to be as valid and effectual as if this Ordinance had been in force at the date upon which it is deemed to have commenced. Validation of regulations.
