I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 46(2) of the *Industrial Relations Act* (Chapter 174) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby give notice that it is proposed to declare the Papua New Guinea Waterside Workers and Seamen's Union Award No. 13 of 1982 to be a Common Rule in relation to all seamen employed on vessels that operate in Papua New Guinea coastal waters other than those seamen employed—

- (a) on vessels that are under 10 metres in length; and
- (b) on vessels of a non-commercial nature; and
- (c) on vessels fully owned by village based development groups as determined by the Secretary for Labour and Employment; and
- (d) in foreign going or overseas vessels; and
- (e) under any other law in Papua New Guinea.

Persons or organizations interested and desiring to object to this common rule are requested to forward their objections in writing so as to reach the Secretary, National Executive Council within six weeks on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette* and all objections so forwarded will be considered by the National Executive Council.
