

Excise Tariff Act (Chapter 107)

EXEMPTION FROM EXCISE DUTY

I, DENNIS YOUNG, C.M.G., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3(1)(b) of the *Excise Tariff Act* (Chapter 107) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby exempt from excise duty all small goods (being the goods referred to in Item 4 of the Schedule to the Act) for a period of three years commencing on and from 1st January, 1991.

Customs Tariff Act (Chapter 101A)

REDUCED RATE OF IMPORT DUTY

I, DENNIS YOUNG, C.M.G., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 8(1)(b) of the *Customs Tariff Act* (Chapter 101A) and all other powers me enabling, hereby reduce to 8 per cent the rate of import duty on the good specified in the Schedule.
