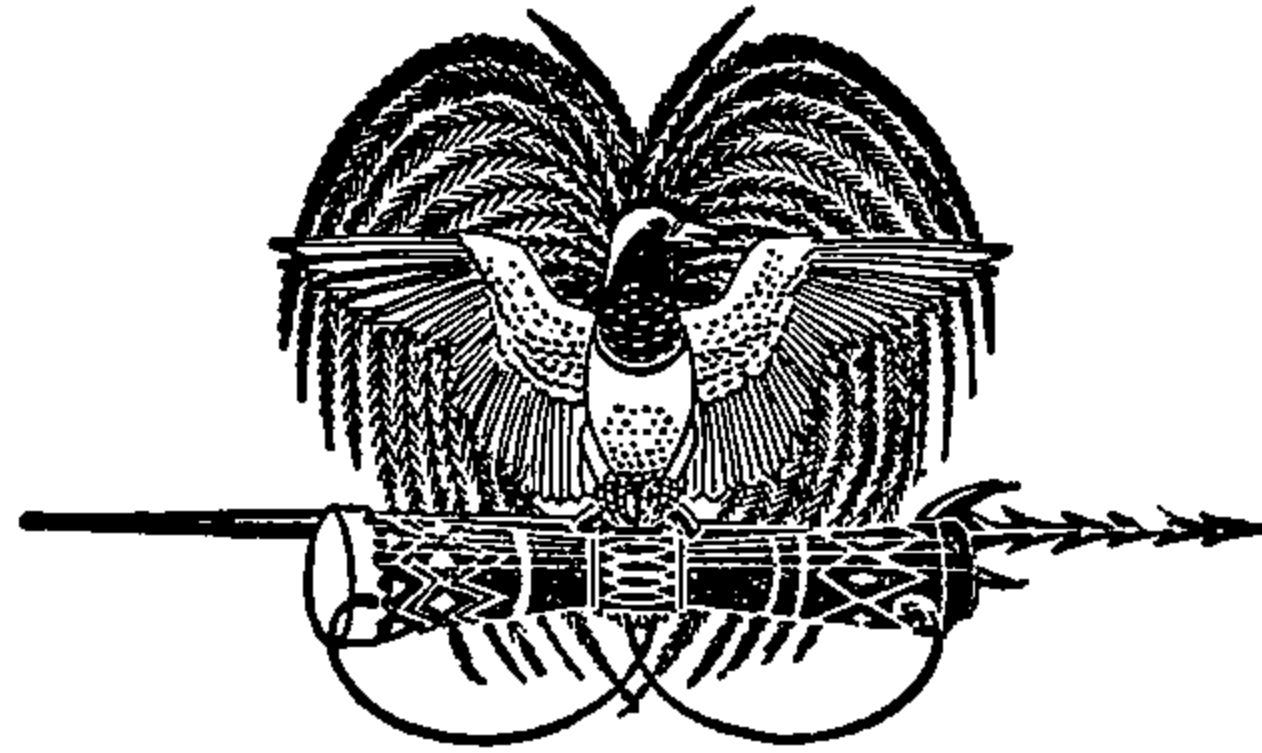

PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Serei Eri, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person within the boundaries of National Capital District (being the boundaries specified in the Organic Law on the boundaries of the National Capital District) to remain within doors between the hours of eleven o'clock in the evening (11 p.m.) and five o'clock in the morning (5 a.m.) for a period of 38 days commencing on and from eleven o'clock in the evening (11 p.m.) on Wednesday, 21st August, 1991.

PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Serei Eri, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person within the boundaries of Morobe Province to remain within doors between the hours of eleven o'clock in the evening (11 p.m.) and five o'clock in the morning (5 a.m.) for a period of 32 days commencing on and from eleven o'clock in the evening (11 p.m.) on Tuesday, 27th August, 1991.
