Albert Karo, MP., he being a person to whom the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership applies, AND ALL OF HIS ASSOCIATES, including members for his family, his relatives and all persons associated with him or with members of his family or with his relatives, are PROHIBITED FROM SEEKING, OBTAINING OR HOLDING any proprietary or possessory interest in the property at Section 14, Allotment 20, City of Port Moresby, Milinch of Granville, Fourmil of Moresby, otherwise known as the " Central Province Premier's residence.

TAKE NOTICE that a person to whom the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership applies who, or whose spouse or child under the voting age, seeks, accepts, obtains or holds any prohibited interest, benefit or property will be guilty of misconduct in office, unless, prior to seeking, or accepting or otherwise obtaining that interest, obtained from the Ombudsman Commission under Section 25 (2) of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership.

Alternatively, if the Ombudsman Commission is satisfied that a person to whom the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership applies or whose spouse or child under voting age has obtained and holds any prohibited interest, benefit or property the Commission may order that benefit or property be disposed of in accordance with Section 26 (1) of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership.
