REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF ACTING COMMANDER AND PROMOTION AND APPOINTMENT OF COMMANDER OF THE DEFENCE FORCE

I, Sir Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193 (1)(f) of the Constitution and Section 6 of the *Defence Act* (Chapter 74), and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council given after consultation with the Public Services Commission, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Colonel Alfred Aikung as acting Commander of the Defence Force; and
- (b) promote Colonel Jack Tuat, to position of Brigadier-General; and
- (c) appoint Brigadier-General Jack Tuat as the Commander of the Defence Force for a period of three (3) years,

commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.
