Defence Force Retirement Benefits Act (Chapter 76)

 - (ii) David Takendu to be a member and Deputy Chairman of the Defence Force Retirement Benefits Board; and
 - (iii) Vari Fore to be a member of the Defence Force Retirement Benefits Board; and
 - (iv) Simon Ketan to be a member of the Defence Force Retirement Benefits Board, for a period of three years,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
