Land Act (Chapter 185)**LAND AVAILABLE FOR LEASING****A. APPLICANT:**

Applicants or Tenderers should note—

1. Full name (block letters), occupation and address;
2. If a Company, the proper Registered Company name and address of the Company representative;
3. If more than one person, the tenancy desired and, if tenancy in common, the division of shares.

Applicants or tenderers should note—

4. That a lease cannot be held in a name registered under the *Business Names Act* only; and
5. That in the case of death in joint tenancy, the deceased partner's interest vests in the surviving partner and, in the case of tenancy in common, the deceased partner's interest vests in his estate.

B. TYPE OF LEASE:
