Curfew Act 1987

AMENDMENT TO PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby amend the Proclamation of Curfew in respect of the National Capital District as contained in the Proclamation of Curfew dated 26th June, 2001 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G77 of 26th June, 2001 as follows:—

By deleting the words and figures “between the hours of seven o’clock in the evening (7.00 p.m.) and five o’clock in the morning (5.00 a.m.) for a period commencing on and from seven o’clock in the evening (7.00 p.m.) on Tuesday 26th June, 2001 until five o’clock in the morning (5.00 a.m.) on Tuesday, 10th July, 2001” and replacing them with the following:—

- “(a) for a period commencing on 12 midnight on 6th July, 2001 until five o’clock in the morning (5.00 a.m.) on 22nd July, 2001, between the hours of 12 midnight and five o’clock in the morning (5.00 a.m.); and
- (b) for a period commencing at ten o’clock in the evening (10 p.m.) on 22nd July, 2001 until 5 a.m. on 25th August, 2001, between the hours of ten o’clock in the evening (10 p.m.) and five o’clock in the morning (5 a.m.).”
