Prime Minister and National Executive Council Act 2002

AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Michael Thomas Somare, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend, with effect on and from 12th November, 2003, the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 29th August, 2002, and published in *National Gazette* No. G138 on 29th August, 2002 (as amended):—

Amendment of Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers:—continued

- (a) in Schedule 2 (Minister for Agriculture and Livestock) in Column 1 by deleting “Mathew Siune” and substituting “Sasa Zibe”; and
- (b) in Schedule 15 (Minister for Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology) in Column 1 by deleting “Don Polye” and substituting “Brian Pulayasi”; and
- (c) in Schedule 20 (Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations) in Column 1 by deleting “Roy Biyama” and substituting “Mathew Siune”; and
- (d) in Schedule 23 (Minister for Finance, National Planning and Monitoring) in Column 1 by deleting “Arthur Somare” and substituting “John Hickey”; and
- (e) in Schedule 14 (Minister for Health) in Column 2 by adding the following words “and Minister Assisting the Prime Minister on HIV/AIDS”; and
- (f) in Schedule 21 (Minister for Lands and Physical Planning and Minister Assisting the Prime Minister on HIV/AIDS) in Column 2 by deleting all the words after the word “Planning”; and
- (g) in Schedule 25 (Minister for Public Service) in Column 2 by adding the words “and Acting Minister for Lands and Physical Planning”; and
- (h) in Schedule 13 (Minister for Forests and Acting Minister for Finance, National Planning and Monitoring) in Column 2 by deleting the words “and Acting Minister for Finance, National Planning and Monitoring”.
