Customs Tariff Act 1990

REDUCED RATE FROM IMPORT DUTY

I, Michael Ogio, C.M.G., C.B.E., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(b) of the *Customs Tariff Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby reduce the rate of import duty to 40% on all payable items as specified in the Schedule in relation to the Sugar supplies to Papua New Guinea Domestic Market effective from 1st April, 2011 up to and including 31st December, 2011.
