**WATER AND SEWERAGE SERVICES PRICES ORDER 2011**

MADE by the Independent Consumer & Competition Commission under Section 21 of the *Prices Regulation Act (Chapter 320)* to amend Notice Relating to Eda Ranu's 2010 Water and Sewerage Tariffs as previously published in the *National Gazette* No. G2 of 4th January, 2010. This new Order is to come into operation as of 1st of January, 2011.

The Notice Relating to Eda Ranu's 2010 Water and Sewerage Tariffs is amended by repealing Schedule 2 to that previous Order and replacing it with the following Schedule 2 for 2011.

This Schedule relates to the Water and Sewerage rates for all water supply and sewerage services supplied by Eda Ranu. All charges and fees (other than arrears) shown on accounts issued on or after 1st January, 2011 become due and payable at the following rates. These rates from the previous gazette shall remain applicable in 2011.
