## WEAPONS AND STOLEN PROPERTY SURRENDER NOTICE 2003

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by respective sections 3(3) of the Amnesty Acts 2000 and 2001, I AUGUSTINE TANEKO, Minister of Justice and Legal Affairs, do make the following notice-

- This Notice may be cited as the Weapons and Stolen Property Surrender Notice 2003
- 2. (a) Midnight 21st day of August 2003, is hereby specified as the time and date on or before which all firearms and ammunition and stolen property in the possession or custody of members of the former militant groups referred to in the Townsville Peace Agreement and Marau Peace Agreement (as defined in the respective Amnesty Acts) shall be surrendered and returned.
  - (b) The firearms and ammunition shall be surrendered in accordance with the firearms Amnesty Notice, issued by the Solomon Islands Government with the assistance of the Regional Assistance Mission to Solomon Islands on 31st July 2003, which commenced at midnight 31st July 2003 and lapsing at midnight 21st August 2003.
  - (c) The stolen property shall be returned to their rightful owners.
- This Notice comes into force on 1st day of August 2003.
