(TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) ACT

(Cap. 84)

THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) (COMMISSIONER OF POLICE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act, the Minister hereby makes the following regulations -

| Citation | 1. | These Regulations may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Commissioner of Police) (Amendment) Regulations 2007, and shall be deemed to have come into force on 11th June, 2007. |
| Amendment
Regulation 4 | 2. | Regulation 4 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Commissioner of Police) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) is hereby amended by deleting the words "an annual taxable salary of \$59,224.75" and substituting therefor the words "a fortnightly taxable salary of \$4,000.00". |
| Amendment
Regulation 6 | 3. | Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the figure \$2,000.00 and substituting therefor the figure "\$10,000.00". |
| Amendment
Regulation 7 | 4. | Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the full stop at the end of the sentence and inserting thereafter the words "or in the absence of a rent free residence, and at the option of the officer he shall receive a housing allowance of \$5,000.00 per month". |

- Deletion & Replacement Regulation 8
5. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is hereby deleted and the following new regulation substituted therefor -
- “Utilities 8. The cost of water, gas, telephone and Electricity Electricity provided to the residence of the Commissioner of Police shall be charged to the public funds and be paid for by the Government or at the option of the Officer he shall be paid a utility allowance of \$1,300.00 per month.”
- Amendment Regulation 10
6. Regulation 10 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the full stop at the end of the sentence and inserting thereafter the following word “and a fuel allowance of \$500.00 per month.
- Amendment Regulation 14(1)
7. Regulation 14(1) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the figure “US\$55.00” and Substituting therefor the figure “US\$250.00.”
- Amendment Regulation 15
8. Regulation 15 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting the figure “\$40.00” and substituting therefor the figure “\$150.00.”
- Deletion & Replacement Regulation 17
9. Regulation 17 of the principal Regulations is hereby deleted and the following new regulation substituted therefor -
- “Clothing Allowance 17. The Commissioner of Police shall receive a clothing allowance of \$10,000.00 per annum.”
- Insertion of new Regulation 24
10. The principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately after regulation 23, the following new regulation as regulation 24 -
- “Education Allowance 24. The Commissioner of Police shall receive an education allowance of \$5,000.00 per annum.”
