SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978 (L.N.NO. 43 of 1978)

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE

IN exercise of the powers conferred by Section 115 (1) of the Constitution, I, **FRANK UTU OFAGIORO KABUI**, Cross of the Order of Solomon Islands, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby appoint:-

JUSTICE FRANCIS MWANESALUA, CBE

to act as Chief Justice of Solomon Islands from the 23rd to the 30th day of October, 2009 and from the 6th to the 16th day of November 2009 respectively, with effect from 23rd October, 2009.

- By virtue of Section 57(2)(a) of the National Parliament (Electoral Provisions) Act, and upon the advice of the Returning Officer, I, Mr. Frank Utu Ofagioro Kabui, CSI, CMG, OBE, Governor-General of Solomon Islands, hereby formally publicise the result of the successful election of **Sir Allen C. Kemakeza** as the duly elected Member of Parliament, for the Savo/Russell Constituency. Sir Allen C. Kemakeza successfully polled 1,654 Votes, while the runner up, Mr. Reginald Hill Kokili polled 957 Votes; a majority of 697 Votes.
