(Act No.2 of 1999)**HONIARA CITY (HONIARA LIQUOR LICENSING BOARD)
ORDER 2010**

WHEREAS the Honiara City Council ("Council") was dissolved at midnight on 26 August 2010 on the expiration of the term of four years of the Council after the last election, and the election of members of the Council is due to be held on 8 December 2010 (Legal Notice 137 of 2010);

WHEREAS the terms of appointment of the members of the Honiara Liquor Licensing Board ("Board") expired on 18 November 2010, its Chairman having resigned in or about July 2010;

WHEREAS the members and Chairman of the Board are required to be appointed by the Mayor under the Liquor Act (Cap. 144);

THEREFORE due to these unforeseen or special circumstances I make this Order pursuant to section 72 of the Honiara City Act to appoint the Board to perform and exercise its powers and functions under the Liquor Act –

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Honiara City (Honiara Liquor Licensing Board) Order 2010.

Appointment of the Board and Acting Chairman 2. (1) The persons who were members of the Board immediately before 18 November 2010 are reappointed by virtue of this Order as members of the Board.

(2) Mr Nela Mosese is appointed by virtue of this Order as Acting Chairman of the Board.

(3) Subject to subparagraph (4), the members are re-appointed for a term of 12 months effective from the date of this Order.

(4) This Order does not affect the power of the Mayor to appoint the Board under the Liquor Act (Cap.144) when the Mayor is elected after the elections of members of the Council scheduled for 8 December 2010.
