## GOVERNMENT ACT (Section 25)

### LEAVE AND LEAVE PASSAGE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1991

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Government Act (Cap. 3), the Cabinet makes the following regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Leave and Leave Passage (Amendment) Regulations 1991.
2. Regulation 20 of the Leave and Leave Passage Regulations 1963, as amended, is deleted and replaced by the following -

"20 (1) School teachers are entitled to vacation leave during school holidays only except those listed herein who shall be treated for leave purposes as civil servants:

- (a) At Tonga Teacher's College: all teachers;
- (b) At Tonga College: the Principal and Deputy Principal; the Woodwork, Metalwork and Agricultural Instructors; and the Senior Tutor.
- (c) At Tonga High School: the Principal, Deputy Principal and Senior Assistant Teacher (Girls).
- (d) Other Government high schools: Principals and Deputy Principals.
- (e) Tonga Maritime Polytechnical Institute: all teachers.
- (f) Community Development and Training Centre: all teachers.

- (2) A school teacher whose basic salary is equal to or greater than the minimum point of the scale for Senior Officers shall be eligible for overseas vacation leave passage grant at the same rate and regularity as a Senior Officer."

## KO E LAO 'A E PULE'ANGA (Kupu 25)

### NGAAHI TU'UTU'UNI (FAKATONUTONU) KI HE MALOLO 'EVE'EVA MO E FOLAU MALOLO 'EVE'EVA 1991

'I he ngaue'aki 'o e ngaahi mafai kuo foaki 'e he kupu 25 'o e Lao 'a e Pule'anga (Vahe 3), 'oku fai ai 'e he Kapineti 'a e ngaahi tu'utu'uni ko 'eni:-

1. 'E ui 'a e ngaahi tu'utu'uni ni ko e Ngaahi Tu'utu'uni (Fakatonutonu) ki he Malolo 'Eve'eva mo e Folau Malolo 'Eve'eva 1991.

2. Ko e kupu 20 'o e Ngaahi Tu'utu'uni ki he Malolo 'Eve'eva mo e Folau Malolo 'Eve'eva 1963, 'i hono fakatonutonu, 'oku to'o ia pea ke fetongi'aki 'eni -

"20 (1) 'Oku totonu ke ma'u 'e he kau faiako 'a e taimi malolo 'eve'eva lolotonga 'oku tutuku 'a e ako tukukehe pe 'a kinautolu 'oku ha atu 'i heni 'a ia kuo pau ke lau koe'uhi ko e ngaahi taumu'a 'o e malolo 'eve'eva 'o hange pe ko ha kau ngaue Faka-Pule'anga:

- (a) 'I he Kolisi Fakafaiako 'a Tonga: kau faiako katoa;
- (b) 'I he Kolisi Tonga: ko e Pule mo e Tokoni Pule; Kau Faiako Ngaue Fakatufunga, Ngaue Fakametale, Ngaue Fakangoue; mo e Tiuta Ma'olunga.
- (c) 'I he Ako'anga Ma'olunga 'a Tonga: ko e Pule, Tokoni Pule mo e Tokoni Faiako Ma'olunga (Tamaiki Fefine).
- (d) Ngaahi Ako'anga Ma'olunga kehe 'a e Pule'anga: kau Pule mo e Kau Tokoni Pule.
- (e) 'Apiako Folau Tahī 'a Tonga: kau faiako katoa.
- (f) 'Apiako ki hono Teu'i mo Fakalalaka ma'a e Kakai: kau faiako katoa.

(2) Ko ha faiako 'a ia ko hono tefito'i vahenga 'oku tatau mo e pe lahiange 'i he vahenga si'isi'i tahā 'i he sikeili ki he Kau 'Ofisa Ma'olunga kuo pau ke ni ma'u 'a e me'a'ofa 'o e folau malolo 'eve'eva ki Tu'a Pule'anga 'i he tu'unga mo e taimi tatau 'o hange ko ha 'Ofisa Ma'olunga."
