CONSUMPTION TAX ACT 2003

(Section 5(3)(a))

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act 2003, the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet makes the following Order –

- (1) That the import of all building materials for the constructions of private dwellings, community project buildings and education project buildings, be exempted from consumption tax.
- (2) That this Order shall have effect from the date of gazettal to 31 December 2020.
