JOINT REGULATION 5 of 1972

JOINT REGULATION

No. 5
of 1972.

to bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1972.

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MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 5, 7, paragraph 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after consultation with the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Majesty and the French Republic.

1. The Regulation may be cited as the 1972 Appropriation Joint Regulation.
2. The Recurrent Estimates of the Joint Administration of the year 1972 shall provide for—
 - (a) Revenue for the amount of five million three thousand and three hundred and five Australian Dollars (\$A5,003,305) or five hundred million three hundred and thirty thousand five hundred and fifty-six New Hebrides francs (500,330,556 FNH).
 - (b) Expenditure to the amount of five million three thousand and three hundred and five Australian dollars (\$A5,003,305) or five hundred million three hundred and thirty thousand five hundred and fifty-six New Hebrides francs (500,330,556 FNH).
3. The Capital Estimates of the Joint Administration of the year 1972 shall provide for—
 - (a) Revenue for the amount of three million one hundred and sixty-six thousand Australian dollars (\$A3,166,000) or three hundred and sixteen million six hundred thousand New Hebrides francs (316,600,000 FNH).
 - (b) Expenditure to the amount of three million one hundred and sixty-six thousand Australian dollars (\$A3,166,000) or three hundred and sixteen million six hundred thousand New Hebrides francs (316,600,000 FNH).
4. There shall be issued from General Revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration and applied to the Service of the year ending December 1972 sums not exceeding those specified in subsection (b) of section 2 and subsection (b) of section 3 of this Regulation. These said amounts shall be appropriated as set out in the Schedule to this Regulation.

5. The Resident Commissioners may jointly authorise the Ordonnateur and the Condominium Treasurer to control expenditure, each according to his responsibilities as set out in Joint Standing Order No. 4 of 1957 within the limits fixed by such authorisation; such sums shall not exceed on the whole the sums specified in subsection (b) of section 2 and subsection (b) of section 3 of this Regulation.
