JOINT REGULATION 8 of 1965

JOINT REGULATION

No. 8 of 1965.

To provide for the regulation of the conditions of service of Officers of the Condominium Service of the Joint Administration.

[Joint Regulation No. 8 of 1965 was published in Condominium Gazette No. 228 and is reprinted as amended by the Joint Regulation No. 6 of 1966 (Condominium Gazette No. 329).]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2, Article 4 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. The Resident Commissioners may by Joint Standing Orders provide for the regulation of the conditions of service of the Officers of the Condominium Service of the Joint Administration.

Powers of the Resident Commissioners to make Joint Standing Orders regulating the conditions of service of Condominium Officers.

2. All Joint Regulations, Rules, Decisions, Orders, Standing Orders, Instructions and Memoranda relating to the conditions of service of the Officers of the Condominium Service of the Joint Administration are hereby repealed, [except for the following texts which are fully and completely valid—

Repeal of previous legislation relating to the conditions of service of Condominium Officers. J.R. No. 6 of 1966.

(a) as regards deferred pay only:

- (1) Joint Decision No. 9 of 1949;
- (2) Joint Memorandum dated 12th September, 1950;
- (3) Joint Letter No. 7 dated 19th July, 1951;

(b) as regards end-of-service gratuity:

- (1) Joint Regulation No. 4 of 1947;
- (2) Joint Memorandum dated 18th December, 1947;

(c) as regards compensation in case of accidents at work Joint Decision No. 18 of 1960.]

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Conditions of Service of Condominium Officers Regulation No. 8 of 1965 and shall
