JOINT REGULATION

No. 14 of 1979

TO PUT INTO EFFECT the Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 10 of 1979, passed the 9th day of May 1979, to amend the Import Duties (Consolidation) Regulation 1975.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 2 (2) of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Article 28 (3) of the Schedule to the Exchange of Notes made at London the 15th day of September 1977 between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the French Republic.

Scheduled Resolution put into effect. 1. The Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 10 of 1979, set forth in the Schedule is hereby put into effect.

Short title and commencement. 2. This Joint Regulation may be cited as the Import Duties (Consolidation) (Amendment No. 2) Regulation 1979 and shall have effect from the

JOINT REGULATION No. 14 of 1979 : SCHEDULE

(REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION No. 10 of 1979)

providing for the reduction of import duty
on gas-oil for the supply of Palekula-
based fishing vessels.

THE REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE NEW HEBRIDES
at its sitting on 9th May 1979.

hereby resolves and decides, in accordance with the schedule to the
exchange of notes of 15th September 1977, Joint Regulation No. 1 of 1978,
Joint Regulation No. 52 of 1975 to consolidate the provisions relating
to Customs Import Duty,

to adopt the following measures :

1. Gas-oil (Customs Import Duty Tariff Classification No. 27-23)
shall be exempt from customs import duty upon presentation to the Customs
Department of documentary proof that such gas-oil is to be supplied to
fishing vessels belonging to the Palekula base on the island of SANTO.
2. Customs service tax shall be reduced to 1% on gas-oil imported
for the purpose indicated in section 1 above.
