

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 39 of 1977

TO AMEND the Joint Public Order Regulation No. 11 of 1974.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Amendment of
No. 11 of 1974.

1. Section 2 of the Joint Public Order Regulation No. 11 of 1974 is amended by adding the following subsection at the end -

" (3) (a) The importation of every uniform, distinct dress or other clothing signifying usage as referred to in subsection (1) (b) (i) or (ii) above and the importation of all flags, whether new or used, shall be subject to the prior joint permission of the Resident Commissioners ;

(b) any article referred to in paragraph (a) above which is imported without the joint permission of the Resident Commissioners may be seized and detained, and any person who so imports any such article shall be **guilty** of an offence."

2. The Schedule to the Joint Public Order Regulation No. 11 of 1974 is amended by adding the following item immediately after item 1 -

"1A. Unlawful importation (section 2 (3) ;
..... Imprisonment for three months or a fine of 20,000 FNH or both."

3. (1) This Regulation may be cited as the Public Order (Amendment) Regulation 1977 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.

(2) This Regulation and the Joint Public Order Regulation No. 11 of 1974, together with every Joint Regulation amending the same, shall be read as one and may be cited as the Public Order Regulations 1974 to 1977.
