COMMISSION

By Walter Hadye Lini, Prime Minister and Minister for Justice

To WILLIAM VICTOR KATTAN

WHEREAS by section 1(1) of Joint Commission of Inquiry Regulation No. 16 of 1974 it is provided that the Prime Minister may whenever he considers it desirable issue a Commission appointing (inter alia) one Commissioner authorising him to inquire into any matter which an inquiry would in his opinion be for the public welfare;

WHEREAS at approximately 5.00 a.m on Wednesday January 16th, 1985, the motor vessel ONMA II foundered with loss of human life and cargo at Aulua bay, N W Bungon Point, Central East Malekula;

AND WHEREAS the Prime Minister considers an inquiry into the loss of the motor vessel the 'ONMA II' is for the public welfare;

NOW THEREFORE by this Commission I appoint you the said **WILLIAM VICTOR KATTAN** to inquire generally into the causes and circumstances that lead to the foundering of the motor vessel ONMA II with loss of cargo, life and personal injury and in particular to inquire into:

- (a) the state of seaworthiness of the said vessel immediately prior to the voyage on which it was lost;
- (b) the adequacy of the manning arrangements and the standards of competency of the master and crew;

- (c) the adequacy of the measures taken by the master for the navigation and control of the said vessel prior to its loss with special reference to weather conditions;
- (d) the adequacy of the life saving devices and appliances and their condition prior to the loss of the vessel;
- (e) the actions taken by the master and crew to preserve the vessel from immediate loss and the action taken by them to preserve any person on board the vessel from immediate danger to life or limb.

The inquiry shall be made at Port Vila and at such other place or places as the Commissioner may determine.

The inquiry shall be held in public at such time or times and on such day or days as the Commissioner may determine.

The Commissioner shall be assisted by two marine assessors.

The Commissioner shall make a report of the proceedings and of the result of his inquiry to the Prime Minister as soon as may be after the termination of the proceedings of the inquiry.
