CIVIL AVIATION ACT NO. 16 OF 1999

Anti-terrorism regulations

Order No. 11 of 2002

To give effect to Resolution 1267 (1999), 1269 (1999), 1333 (2000) and 1390 (2002) of the United Nations Security Council

In exercise of the powers under section 129 of the Civil Aviation Act No. 16 of 1999, I, the Honourable Jacklyn Reuben Titek, Minister of Infrastructure and Public Utilities, make the following regulations.

1 Interpretation

In these regulations:

entity means an individual, group, trust, partnership, or fund, or an incorporated or unincorporated association or organisation.

terrorist entity means the Taliban, Al-Qaida or any other entity designated from time to time:

- (a) by the Committee established by paragraph 6 of Resolution 1267(1999) of the United Nations Security Council; or
- (b) by or under one or more other resolutions of the United Nations Security Council.

2 Terrorist aircraft


An aircraft must not land, take off or pass through the airspace controlled by Vanuatu if:


- (a) the aircraft is, or there are reasonable grounds to suspect the aircraft is, owned, leased or operated by or on behalf of a terrorist entity; or
- (b) the aircraft is, or there are reasonable grounds to suspect the aircraft is, carrying arms, ammunition, military equipment, spare parts or related materials intended for use by a terrorist entity.

3 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day on which they are published in the Gazette.

SHIPPING ACT [CAP 53]

Anti-terrorism regulations Order No. 12 of 2002

To give effect to Resolution 1267 (1999), 1269 (1999), 1333 (2000) and 1390 (2002) of the United Nations Security Council

In exercise of the powers under section 45 of the Shipping Act [CAP 53], I, the Honourable Jacklyn Reuben Titek, Minister for Infrastructure and Public Utilities, make the following regulations.

1 Interpretation

In these regulations:

Act means the Shipping Act [CAP 53].

entity means an individual, a group of individuals, an incorporated or unincorporated association or organisation, or any other body.

terrorist entity means the Taliban, Al-Qaida or any other entity designated from time to time:

- (a) by the Committee established by paragraph 6 of Resolution 1267(1999) of the United Nations Security Council; or
- (b) by or under one or more other resolutions of the United Nations Security Council.

2 Terrorist vessels


A vessel registered by or under the Act must not carry upon it:

- (a) any individual who is, or is reasonably suspected of being, a terrorist entity; or
- (b) any cargo of any kind that is, or is reasonably suspected of being, owned, possessed or intended for delivery to a terrorist entity.

3 Commencement

These regulations commence on the day on which they are published in the Gazette.
